

EMERGENCY EVACUATION INFORMATION

In a condition the grandstands need to be evacuated, the following procedure will be used to ensure the safety of our customers.

- Management will notify crowd management, fire, and EMS personnel by radio
- Crowd management personnel will start getting into position to assist with grandstand evacuation
- The PA system will be used to notify spectators that there is an emergency and that the grandstands need to be vacated
- If the emergency is severe enough, the front large gate will be opened to allow quicker exit of the spectators
- Crowd management personnel may need to assist with wheelchair and other mobility impaired spectators

In a condition the grandstands and the infield need to be evacuated, the following procedure will be used to ensure the safety of our customers.

- Management will notify crowd management, fire, and EMS personnel by radio
- Crowd management personnel will start getting into position to assist with grandstand or infield evacuation depending on work area assignment
- The PA system will be used to notify spectators that there is an emergency and that the grandstands and the infield need to be vacated
- If the emergency is severe enough, the front large gate will be opened to allow quicker exit of the spectators
- Crowd management personnel may need to assist with wheelchair and other mobility impaired spectators
- Management will keep in touch with crowd management, fire, and EMS personnel by radio
- Employees must meet in the office area to check in with your assigned supervisor in this situation. Do not leave until your supervisor knows. We don't want to put someone in harm's way if you have already left the speedway property
